- Students are required to obtain a minimum 1 pass (H2) and 3 sub-passes (GP and 2 other subjects) to be promoted to JC2.
 - ❑ H1 Mother Tongue Language is not relevant when calculating promotional requirements.

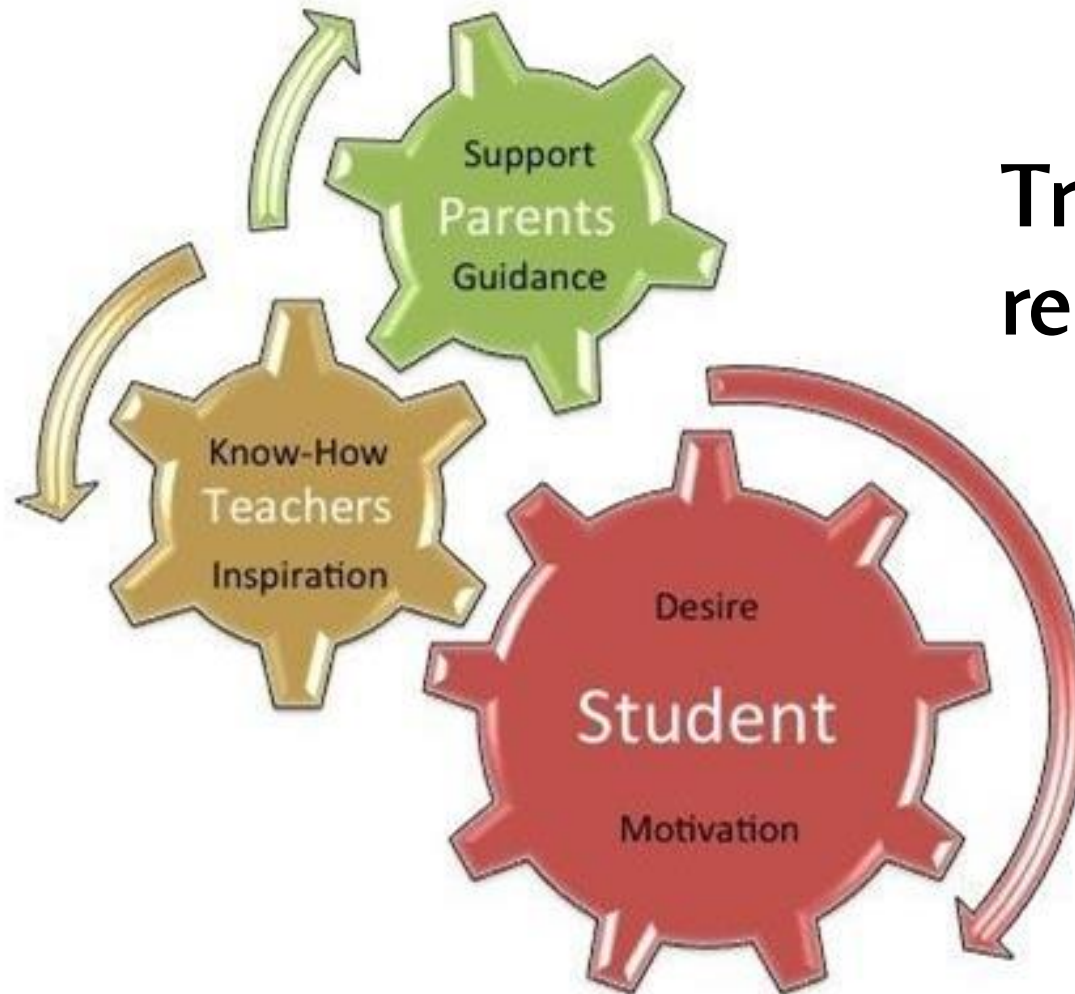


Expectations of students
