JC1 Assessment Guidelines

- As announced by MOE, there will be no Mid-Year Exams.
- As such, the college has adjusted its school-based assessment schedule and weightage, based on student needs and sound assessment principles:
 - Management of overall assessment load and demands for sustainable learning
 - Formative assessment of Home-based Learning, to identify and close learning gaps
 - Sufficient practice to prepare students for promotion to JC2
